

TOWN OF HARRISVILLE

LANDFILL-RECYCLING FACILITY ORDINANCE

Pursuant to the authority of R.S.A. 31:39, R.S.A. 147, and R.S.A.149-M:13, II. the Town of Harrisville hereby adopts the following ordinance for the operation of its public disposal facility to be known as the Landfill-Recycling Facility.

1. HOURS

THE LANDFILL-RECYCLING FACILITY WILL BE OPEN for use by Harrisville residents and non-resident property owners during the following days and hours and under the following conditions:

A. Admission to the facility will be only by permit issued annually by the Board of Selectmen upon application to the Selectmen by an appropriate person, business or institution. All permits must be attached to a motor vehicle and must be visible.

B. The facility will be open the following days and hours.

11.00 AM to 5:00 PM Friday

8 00 AM to 6:00 PM Saturday

(The Board of Selectmen, after conducting a Public Hearing, may adjust the hours of operation.)

2. SEPARATION

All material brought to the facility for disposal shall be separated into the following categories to be disposed into designated containers or locations as the Landfill-Recycling attendant directs:

| A. Clear glass | Means empty, rinsed containers
No ceramics, window glass or light bulbs
Labels, rings and plastic parts must be removed. |
| B. Green glass | SEE ABOVE |
| C. Brown glass | SEE ABOVE |
| D. Metal cans and containers | Shall mean empty tin, steel containers of a size one gallon or smaller, label removed and rinsed clean. |
| E. Paper | Shall mean clean, dry paper separated as to newspapers, cardboard and brown paper bags.
NOTE: All other paper products, such as junk mail, catalogs, and magazines, shall be disposed of as regular garbage. |
| F. Aluminum | All aluminum cans less than one gallon in size and all clean aluminum foil. |

G. Large metal objects	Means scrap metal of all kinds, automobile parts, pipe, wire, appliances, sheet metal, motors, bed springs, etc. Large non-metal parts and cords must be removed.
H. Tires	Means automobile, truck, motorcycle, and bicycle tires removed from wheel or rim.
I. Leaves and Clippings	Means all lawn clippings, green and dry garden waste and manure. (To be dumped in the compost pile.)
J. Tree limbs & brush	Means all tree limbs and brush, Leaves, brush, and slash 5 inches or less in diameter (State Controlled).
K. Building material	Means refuse from demolished buildings (Burnables to be separated from non burnables.) Untreated wood and untreated dimensional lumber with an end cross-sectional area of 24 square inches or less
L. Demolition debris	See Building material above.
M. Dead animals	BY SPECIAL ARRANGEMENTS ONLY
N. Used motor oil	Leave in custody of attendant.
O. Garbage - Trash	Means any other residential waste not otherwise listed.
P. Batteries	Place used automobile batteries on pallet designated by attendant. All others as directed by Recycling Attendant.
Q. Rags	Dry and reasonably clean, give to attendant. Leather goods, shoes, oil cloth or greasy rags go into the trash.
R. Books	Should be separated and placed on shelves in shed and may be taken away free of charge.
S. Wire	Means all chicken wire, construction wire etc. Ask attendant
T. Mattresses - Boxsprings	Ask Recycle Attendant
U. Furniture and Entertainment Units	Ask Recycle Attendant.
V. Newspaper	Clean and dry newspaper. All inserts are O.K.
W. Paint	If at least one-half full, give to Attendant. Less than one-half full, place with old paint cans. All spray cans are to be placed in trash.

- X. Pallets Any size pallet or skid. Ask Attendant
- Y. Flea Market Usable items. Ask Attendant. Non-usable or defective go in trash.
- Z. Truck & Car bodies All truck & car bodies shall be cut up sections no longer than 36 inches. See above Large Metal Objects.

3. UNACCEPTABLE MATERIALS

A. Harmful, hazardous or toxic substances (per list on file at the Selectmen's Office).

4. SUPERVISION

The Landfill-Recycling Attendants shall have the right to refuse the use of the facility to any person, corporation or other user who is misusing the facility, or is violating this ordinance, or who does not have the proper permit. Any user who refused to obey the legitimate orders of the attendants shall be guilty of violating this ordinance.

5. BURNING

No burning shall be allowed at the facility; except at the direction of the District Fire Warden.

6. FIREARMS

THE DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS IS ABSOLUTELY PROHIBITED AT THE FACILITY.

7. ORIGIN OF MATERIAL DISPOSED OF AT THE FACILITY

Only material collected within the limits of the Town of Harrisville shall be disposed of at the Landfill.

8. COMMERCIAL HAULERS

A commercial hauler shall mean anyone who hauls material to the facility for others for a fee. All persons or corporations engaged in the commercial hauling of rubbish, materials, etc., must first obtain a permit from the Board of Selectmen after payment of the permit fee of \$100 (one hundred dollars) per year. Violation of regulations will result in the revocation of permit, first offense for 30 days and second offense for one year. The hauler will also be subject to the fines listed in this Ordinance.

9. TRESPASS

The gate will be locked at all times when the Landfill is not open to the public. Anyone entering the landfill when the gate is locked is guilty of trespass and shall be charged a fine of \$200.00 (two hundred dollars).

10. ILLEGAL DUMPING

Discharging Trash near the gate or elsewhere on the premises during NON-Dumping HOURS is a violation and subject to a \$200.00 (two hundred dollar) fine.

11. FINES --- RECYCLE OPTION

The Town is aware that some persons and businesses will find it difficult, if not impossible, to recycle waste material.

Taking the above fact into consideration, together with the evidence that such un-recycled waste material will create additional expense for the Town in recycling or removing said material from the Landfill-Recycling Facility, the following fees will be assessed by the Town against the registered holder of the numbered permit attached to the motor vehicle at the facility, for unsorted material brought to the facility in that vehicle:

1. \$10.00 per trip for any passenger vehicle (sedans, convertibles, station wagons).
2. \$20.00 per trip for any trucks, vans, and trailer to 3/4 ton.
3. \$60.00 per trip for trucks larger than 3/4 ton.

12. EXEMPTION

In special circumstances the fees may be waived by the Selectmen.

13. PENALTY

Any person or corporation convicted of violating any provision of this Ordinance or the directives of the Landfill Attendant may be punished by a fine of \$25.00 for each violation payable to the Town of Harrisville. The only exception to the above is the Trespass, Illegal Dumping Fines and the Fines for failing to recycle (see Number 9, Number 10 and Number 11 above).

14. SEPARABILITY

The invalidity of any provisions of this Ordinance shall not affect the validity of any other provision nor the validity of the Ordinance as a whole.

15. This Ordinance shall automatically repeal any other ordinance that is in conflict with this Ordinance.

16. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall take effective September 14, 1989.
