Selectmen met with Dennis Fallon representing the Silver Lake Association. He thanked the Board for donations made last year toward the portable toilets placed at the boat landing. This year the Town has paid for portable toilets at beaches and boat landings. Dennis is also chairman of the Association's Lake Host program; the Association gets some reimbursement from the State and pays the balance to volunteers who inspect boats for invasive weeds.

Reviewed Items:

Approved the amount of \$695.00, to cover expenses of removing beaver dam impacting town trails, and directed it be charged to the Recreation Accounts.

Monadnock Security System furnished an annual Test Inspection for alarm systems at Town Offices and the library.

Review of bills from DuBois & King, Phil's Tree Service and Vachon Clukay & Company. Bills need to be submitted with account numbers already assigned for proper Selectboard review.

Selectmen signed a Timber Yield Tax Warrant directed to Edward and Ellen Bernard.

Department Items:

Planning Board submitted Meeting Minutes for April 9 and May 14, 2014.

Selectmen will have the regularly scheduled meeting for June 12th posted at 6 PM, and will conduct a Public Hearing on new Recycling Center regulations and policies at 7 PM. Angela should notify Recycling Center Manager Phyllis Tarr and post the meeting in the Keene Sentinel as well as around town. Charles will arrange for the Town website to include notice of the Public Hearing.

Other business:

Email was received from Keith Pancake complaining about dogs running unleashed behind his house. Selectmen have no information about the incident. Apparently Police Chief Buddy Driscoll had informed Keith that the leash law did not support the restrictions on the dogs Keith would prefer. Selectmen ask Angela to invite Keith to a future Selectboard meeting if he wished to discuss the matter further.

NH DES provided notification of ongoing Wetland Routine and Railway Maintenance Activities – checking and repairing culverts on the road between Harrisville and Nelson.

Selectmen discussed status of planned culvert work on Prospect Street with Road Agent Wes Tarr. Wes had hoped to locate a piece of culvert (not of standard diameter) that would allow repair of the outfall end of the existing culvert. This may no longer be available. Seth will assist in locating materials. The work may not be scheduled until fall to coordinate with a lake drawdown.

Wes Tarr and at least one Selectmen will arrange a meeting on June 2nd at 8 AM with Historic Harrisville to discuss drainage concerns on Church Street.
